

Volunteer Opportunities Overview

Board Membership - Virtual meetings, six per year to provide strategic guidance and fiduciary oversight and fundraise for the organization and make personal contributions; board members must serve on at least one committee (financial, long-range planning, strategic planning, special event, etc...)

Education Committee Membership- Virtual meeting service to review and assess program quality, diversity of programming, and attend and support annual educator conference and artist training sessions

Youth and Families Support Volunteer - Hands-on events with artists, greeting guests, assisting with artist set-up and clean up, and craft and visual arts activities assistance, or community mural events, as well as garden and living mural volunteer days, and mentorship summer bridge volunteering (two weeks during summer)

Social Media Ambassador - Provide strategic leadership, engagement, and social media content deliverables to bring awareness and critical support to the mission and issues affecting youth

Art Kit Ambassador - Partner with organizational staff to identify critical needs for youth to provide access to free art supplies and at-home materials to support creative development and learning for underserved families

Special Event Committee Membership - Support annual fundraising through committee service, providing guidance and deliverables to increase financial support to the organization; events include annual community gala, golf tournaments, etc...

Youth Leadership Board Membership - College and high school age students seeking to develop leadership skills and affect change within their surrounding communities
