The responsibilities of this position include:

Outreach and Communications:

- Develop and distribute communications and marketing materials for organization, including general communication, program flyers, and social media posts
- Solicit organizational in-kind contributions as needed for events and activities
- Attend weekend activities as needed, collect contact information from guests and input in tracking sheet for growing the communications list
- Assist with YAH volunteer activities and communication, including recruitment and summer youth mentors

Programs and Services:

- Attend and serve as community representative at public events and programs building awareness for the organization
- Maintain and increase community relationships and programs
- Document programs, artist evaluation, and feedback
- Learn to create stakeholder evaluation and impact reports

Administration:

- Create contact lists spreadsheets of schools and site partners
- Organize data and convert into visual aid
- Work with program staff to ensure program content is updated and accurate
- Other duties as assigned
